

The Hatted Boy Format (M-1) shows the Mutual Book Company on the title page as well as on the front cover. The text here is the same as the hard cover Trade copies as it carries the same type blemishes. Since no hard cover books were found which carried the Mutual Company's name on the title page, I conclude that the Mutual Book Company set of thirty-one paperback titles is the only Alger format Mutual produced, hard or soft cover.
